SUBJECT: Fifth Annual Motorcycle Safety Day

1. Fort Knox will hold its fifth annual Motorcycle Safety Day at Olive Theater and Kilianski Sports Complex on Tuesday, 4 May 2010, from 0800 to approximately 1530. This important training provides a venue for new and experienced riders to improve their motorcycle education and safety awareness through a variety of training seminars focused on riding responsibly.
2. To reduce the number of accidents involving motorcycles, I have designated this event as official training and the official duty station for all military motorcycle operators and civilian employees who operate a motorcycle on Fort Knox. Supervisors of civilian employees shall grant their employees time to attend training as mission permits. DA Civilians may attend morning training in a duty status, but must be in a leave status for afternoon participation in planned events. Contractors must be in a leave status with their company for all training scheduled for this day. Participants are not required to ride their motorcycle to this training.
3. I fully support this initiative and expect enthusiastic participation by all Armor Center personnel. Participants involved in non-critical operations will be excused from their regular work area to attend training. All commanders, directors, and chiefs should allow maximum participation. With the potential for accident losses increasing during the summer months, now is the time to conduct prevention programs.
