



## Fort Knox Child and Youth Services (CYS) Program and Services in Support of the Army Family Covenant



In accordance with the Army Family Covenant, effective 1 Jan 08, Fort Knox CYC provides the following support services to children and youth impacted by a parent/guardian deployed or supporting the Global War on Terrorism (GWOT). **Prior to receiving services, patrons must provide the CYC Central Registration Office with a copy of the deployment orders in order to determine eligibility.**

### **Central Registration Office (502) 624- 6703 – Bldg 1384**

- **Registration fees are waived for all CYC patrons effective 1 Dec 07**  
The Central Registration office is located in the basement of Bldg 1384, Vine Grove Road  
Office hours are Monday – Friday 0800 – 1600. Registrations are offered by appointment Mon, Wed, Thu, Fri – walk-in registrations are taken every Tuesday 8:30 – 12:30.
- **Free Child Care during Family Readiness Group (FRG) meetings and at on-site child care settings** -Must be pre-arranged through CYC Outreach Services by calling (502) 624-4483.

### **Child Development Center (CDC) (502) 624-6702/6708 – Bldg 4249 and 4250**

- **Free Hourly Respite Care**--16 hours free child care per child, per month for deployed sponsor, or TCS, TDY & PCS unaccompanied sponsor; 5 hours free child care per child, per month for rear-detachment; 16 hours free child care per child, per month for Wounded Warrior during designated eligible period, unlimited hourly care for medical appointments approved by Warrior in Transition Unit (WTU) or Army Wounded Warrior (AW2); 40 hours free child care initially for family of deceased soldier, 16 hours per child, per month during designated eligible period after that.
- **Reduction in Full Day and Part Day Child Care Fees**-Beginning 1 Jan 08 there will be 20% fee reduction for first child and 20% reduction for second and multiple children of deployed soldiers/DoD civilians; Cat 1 fees apply to Wounded Warriors.
- **Reduction in Hourly Care Fees**-Beginning 1 Jan 08 rate is \$2.00 per hour per child for deployed Sponsor on TCS, PCS, TDY, or Rear Detachment, Wounded and Fallen Warriors.
- **Special Evening Opening the third Friday of each month 6:30–10:00 pm.** Free hourly care is provided for children ages 6 weeks – 5<sup>th</sup> grade. Reservations are due NLT one week prior to the opening. Call 624-6708 for reservations.
- **Super Saturdays**-Free care one Saturday each month. Contact CDC for dates and times for these special openings.

## **School Age Services (SAS) (502) 624-6903 – Bldg 4768**

- **Free Hourly Respite Care**--16 hours free child care per child, per month for deployed sponsor, or TCS, TDY & PCS unaccompanied sponsor; 5 hours free child care per child, per month for rear-detachment; 16 hours free child care per child, per month for Wounded Warrior during designated eligible period, unlimited hourly care for medical appointments approved by WTU or AW2; 40 hours free child care initially for family of deceased soldier, 16 hours per child, per month during designated eligible period after that.
- **Reduction in Full Day and Part Day Child Care Fees**--Beginning 1 Jan 08 there will be 20% fee reduction for first child and 20% reduction for second and multiple children of deployed soldiers/DoD civilians; Cat 1 fees apply to Wounded Warriors.
- **Reduction in Hourly Care Fees**--Beginning 1 Jan 08 rate is \$2.00 per hour per child for deployed, Sponsor on TCS, PCS, TDY, or Rear Detachment, Wounded and Fallen Warriors.
- **Special Saturday Openings**--Free care one Saturday each month when SAS is open for special trips and events. Contact SAS for dates and times for the scheduled dates and times. Care is provided for children in 1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> grades

## **Family Child Care (FCC) (502) 624-6706 – Bldg 4768 Annex**

- **Extended Duty Care**--Care is provided for children 4 weeks - 5<sup>th</sup> Grade. In home, certified care is provided by a registered provider residing in government quarters. Additional hours will be provided when care is required beyond the normal duty day.
- **Free Hourly Respite Care**--16 hours free child care per child, per month for deployed sponsor, or TCS, TDY & PCS unaccompanied sponsor; 5 hours free child care per child, per month for rear-detachment; 16 hours free child care per child, per month for Wounded Warrior during designated eligible period, unlimited hourly care for medical appointments approved by WTU or AW2; 40 hours free child care initially for family of deceased soldier, 16 hours per child, per month during designated eligible period after that.
- **Reduction in Full Day and Part Day Child Care Fees**--same as CDC above.

## **Instructional Programs/SKIES *Unlimited* (502) 624-3126**

- **FREE Instructional Classes**--Four free classes (not to exceed 8 weeks per class) for deployed soldiers, Wounded Warriors and Fallen Soldiers while deployed, during designated support assignment or eligible time period. Two free Instructional Classes for Sponsor on TCS, PCS, TDY, or Rear Detachment during designated support assignment.

## **Youth Services (YS) (502) 624-6442**

- **Middle School and Teen Program (502) 624-6442 – Bldg 5543**  
**Free event/activity fees** (lock-ins, dances, trips, etc.) for youth in 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grades. Call the youth center for hours of operation and dates for special events.
- **Youth Sports (502) 624-4747 – Bldg 4990**  
**Free Team Sports Fees**--Two Team or Individual Sport per child for deployed, Wounded Warriors and Fallen Soldiers while deployed, during designated support assignment or eligible time period; One Team or Individual Sport per child for if sponsor on TCS, PCS, TDY, or Rear Detachment during designated support assignment.
