SUBJECT: Thunderbolt Six Policy Memo No. 38-43 - Fort Knox Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Board

1. Reference AR 190-24, Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Boards and Off-Installation Liaison and Operations, 30 June 1993.

2. The Fort Knox Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Board (AFDCB) will take action on all reports considered detrimental to the health, welfare, safety, morals, morale and discipline of the Fort Knox community. The AFDCB makes recommendations to the Fort Knox Commander to eliminate these adverse conditions. The AFDCB will meet annually to review current off-limits establishments and the President of the Board may call special meetings when circumstances warrant. All establishments concerned will be notified per AR 190-24.

3. The AFDCB consists of voting members representing the following agencies:


