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WARNINGS

OPSEC

Nonsecure communication/information exchange is extremely vulnerable to hostile exploitation through monitoring. Do not attempt to talk around a classified or sensitive subject. Accumulated bits of seemingly unimportant information collected through continued monitoring when analyzed can provide Hostile Intelligence Services with vital National Defense Information. (AR 530-1.)

CONTROL OF TELEPHONE USAGE

Unofficial use of DSN, FTS2000, or any other DoD funded telephone system is prohibited. Personnel found fraudulently using DoD telephone systems are subject to be disciplined to the maximum extent possible. Individuals found placing unofficial toll calls will pay for incurred charges.

Third party monitoring of a telephone conversation is prohibited unless all parties give consent (an exception is at Site R where OPSEC monitoring is authorized). This also applies to use of hands-free speaker telephones when more than one person is present at hands-free locations.

DO NOT PROCESS, STORE OR TRANSMIT CLASSIFIED INFORMATION ON NONSECURE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS. OFFICIAL DOD TELECOMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS INCLUDING TELEPHONES, FACSIMILE MACHINES, COMPUTER NETWORKS, AND MODEMS ARE SUBJECT TO MONITORING FOR TELECOMMUNICATIONS SECURITY PURPOSES AT ALL TIMES. USE OF OFFICIAL DOD TELECOMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS CONSTITUTES CONSENT TO TELECOMMUNICATIONS SECURITY MONITORING.

DoD Telecommunications Systems, including telephones, facsimile machines, computer networks and modems are provided for the transmission of official government information only and are subject to communications security monitoring at all times. Use of official DoD Telecommunications Systems constitutes consent to communications security monitoring in accordance with AR 380-53.

PENALTIES

It is unlawful to use telephones making an intrastate, interstate or foreign communication as a means of conveying obscene or indecent language or to telephone anonymously another person repeatedly for the purpose of annoying, molesting or harassing such person or his or her family.

The Penal Code of Kentucky, provides that: Any person who willfully refuses to relinquish immediately a party line when informed that

it is needed for an emergency call to a fire department, a police department or for medical aid or ambulance service, is guilty of an offense and subject to a fine or imprisonment or both. The statute defines an emergency as a situation in which property or human life are in jeopardy and the prompt summoning of aid is essential. It is also made an offense subject to the use of a party line by falsely stating that it is needed for such an emergency.

Anyone with intent to defraud, who gives information to the operator or agent of any telephone company so that the charge therefore is made to the account of another without his authorization, shall be liable to fine or imprisonment or both. (KRS 438.160 TO 180 and KRS514.060.)

FEDERAL LAW provides that harassing interstate communications are a felony subject to imprisonment for up to two years. (47 USC223(a).)

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. DIALING PROCEDURES:

- a. Calls to Louisville, dial 99 and 7-digit number, Calls to Elizabethtown, dial 99 and 7-digit number.
- b. 1-800 (Inward WATS, Toll Free) and 0+ (Operator Assist.) calls can be placed by dialing 99 and the service desired.
- c. Calls to military installations (DSN), dial 94, dial the 7-digit number.
- d. Kentucky numbers NOT served by FX, dial 99, dial 1, dial Area Code and 7-digit number.

2. CLASSIFICATION OF SERVICE:

All telephone service is authorized only for the transaction of official business and will not be used for personal calls.

- a. Class A1: Class A1 service has access to all phone systems serving the installation. These include DSN, FX (Foreign Exchange), FTS2000 (long distance service for all DoD activities) and the local calling area.
- b. Class A2: Class A2 service is the same as A1 less DSN.
- c. Class C: Class C service has access to all Fort Knox and 942/943 numbers. Exceptions to limitations are given for the transfer of data/facsimile or in special situations such as alerts, exercises or emergencies. Within these classifications, service can be configured to limit calling areas not mission essential. When requesting service, list areas and circuits to be accessed.

3. REPAIRS AND COMPLAINTS:

- a. Repairs on out-of-order phones may be obtained by calling Repair Service at 4-3338. Repairs on ADP equipment or copiers may be obtained by calling Repair Service at 4-6666.

GENERAL INFORMATION

All repairs will be made during normal duty hours except those telephones on the Emergency Repair List (i.e., Guard, MP, Ambulance, etc.).

- b. Complaints concerning quality of service should be directed to the Administrative Telephone Services Branch, NEC, 4-4444, or in writing to the Director, NEC.

4. DIRECTORY SERVICE:

- a. NEC maintains the information directory service for Fort Knox. This service and the telephone directory contain the phone number and location for each office and unit on Fort Knox that has telephone service provided by NEC.
- b. Changes or corrections to directory listings will be reported to NEC, Administrative Telephone Services Branch, by the Information Management Officer of the unit/office involved.

This directory and the telephone information switchboard directory are compiled from listings furnished by organizations and individuals.

5. REQUESTS FOR SERVICE:

Requests for installation, removal, moves or changes in class of service will be submitted on DA Form 3938 (Local Service Request) to NEC, ATTN: ATZK-IMR-L, Building 1227.

6. EQUIPMENT RESPONSIBILITY:

- a. Individuals in whose area (shop, office, warehouse) telephones are installed are responsible for their proper use and care.
- b. Subscribers will not move, alter, paint, place attachments on, make additions to or change telephone equipment of the systems in any way.
- c. Subscribers who have a need to install special devices (answering/fax machines, recorders, modems, etc.) to the system must request authorization by submitting a memo to NEC outlining equipment to be installed and what telephone numbers are affected.

- d. Any damage to equipment other than fair wear and tear will be covered by a report of survey, statement of charges or cash collection voucher.

7. LOCAL AREA SERVICE:

Numbers with a prefix of 351, 352, 422, 496, 497, 547, 828, 877, 942 and 943 can be accessed from Class A1 or A2 phones by dialing 99 and then the 7-digit number. 942/943 numbers can be accessed from Class C phones by dialing 99 and then the 7-digit number.

8. LONG DISTANCE CALLING FACILITIES:

Fort Knox is serviced by a mixture of long distance services and nets engineered to provide efficient service as economically as possible. The services and nets by priority for use areas follows:

- a. DSN: The DSN circuits are first choice when calling another military installation or a facility that is in the DSN network.
- b. FX: The Foreign Exchange circuits provide service to Louisville and Elizabethtown.
- c. 800 (toll free) and 0+ (operator assist.) services are accessed by dialing 99.
- d. FTS2000: The FTS2000 circuits are used to access government and commercial numbers that cannot be called by FX or DSN, and is the commercial long distance carrier serving Fort Knox. FTS2000 is authorized for official communications only. Use only in those instances when the calls are essential in the conduct of official business and timeliness does not allow alternate means, i.e., mail, email, etc. FTS2000 is time sensitive. Keep your conversation short and businesslike. Make notes before calling concerning topics, questions and points of concern. Please do not engage in casual pleasantries.

9. GOVERNMENT TRANSIENT QUARTERS OCCUPANTS TELEPHONE SERVICE:

Current regulations permit official visiting personnel on a military installation to have access to official telephone facilities, to include locations other than duty sites, to conduct official mission essential business. Visiting personnel are defined as VIPs, officers, Senior NCOs and DA government employees on short-term TDY tours. Personnel on TDY to service schools, annual active-duty training (Reserve Components), etc., are not considered to be in this category. Visiting personnel may obtain service as follows:

- a. From any official telephone (624 number) dial "0" and/or from an unofficial telephone (942/943 number) dial 4-1181.
- b. Upon response by the operator, advise that you are a visitor authorized official telephone service and desire to place a call.
- c. The telephone operator will request and must be provided with the following information:

GENERAL INFORMATION

Name, grade and home organization.
Quarters location, to include building and room numbers.
Telephone number from which call is being placed.
Place and number to be called.

- d. When provided with the information at c, above, the operator will place the call. If the call can be made via official Government circuits (FX, DSN), it will be made toll free. However, if call must go via toll circuits, the caller will have to provide third-number billing information, credit card number or direct the call be made collect.

10. MINIMIZE:

Minimize is a procedure used during periods of crisis or other abnormal periods to reduce volume of record and long-distance voice traffic ordinarily transmitted electrically. When minimize is imposed, subscribers must ensure traffic meets the minimize test outlined in AR 25-1.

11. DATA TRANSMISSION:

Special arrangements can be made with NEC for making data calls from Class C, lines via operator handled circuits. Questions concerning these calls should be directed to the Chief, Administrative Telephone Services, 4-4444.

12. UNOFFICIAL TELEPHONES:

All unofficial telephone service on the installation (formerly Class B service) is provided by the Bell South Telephone Company. Questions concerning this service should be directed to 557-6500 (Residence Service), 557-6000 (Business Service). Repair requests should be directed to 557-6111.

13. PUBLIC TELEPHONES:

All public telephones on the installation are owned and operated by commercial telephone companies. Commanders/Directors having questions concerning public telephone locations should direct their questions to AAFES, 942-4218.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ELECTRONIC MAIL USE

Due to the increased use of Electronic Mail, and the capability of ASIMS users to access the mainframe, the Directorate of Information Management has developed the following requirements:

- a. All requests for passwords must be approved by the organizational Information Management Officer and forwarded to NEC.
- b. A Terminal Area Security Officer must be appointed, in writing, for each terminal (or group of terminals) connected to the network. A copy of the appointment orders will be forwarded to NEC, ATTN: ISSO.

- c. Form 188 (Functional User Request) will list the NACI/NAC completion date of the individual. These dates will be verified by the Security Manager of each staff section.
- d. TASOs will be notified when passwords are ready for pickup. If not picked up within 30 days, the passwords will be deleted from the system.
- e. If a user does not access the system within 90 days, the user will be deleted. If there is a legitimate reason for not accessing the system, notify the Administrator, 4-5176, or the NEC ISSO, 4-7665.
- f. Users should monitor their message and note logs daily to ensure that unneeded data is removed from the system if they are Office Visions users. If you are a Microsoft Exchange user, then you need to make sure your inbox and sent items folders are kept updated.
- g. A copy of the accreditation document (not the accreditation packet) for the terminal networked to the mainframe is to be furnished to the NEC ISSO.
- h. If an organizational user is required, indicate that fact on the Form 188, and if the password is to be shared for backup purposes, list all individuals that will have access to the password.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARING DA FORM 3938

All telephone and data work other than trouble requires a DA Form 3938 to be submitted. Use outline below to aid in filling out the form. Instruction numbers are keyed to blocks on attached form.

1. Plan your needs and allow as much lead time as possible.

SEE REMARKS

2. Send to: NEC, ATTN: ATZK-IMR-L. Forms may be procured through NEC Publications or an automated form may be used. Forms may be typed or printed and forwarded in one copy.
3. List name and phone number of person with exact knowledge of location and work requested.
4. Install: If request is for a new main line, put 1 in Main Line block. (Always 1 as there can be only 1 main line on any number.) If you want additional extensions of a new line, put the amount needed in the extension block (the two totaled should equal the total number of instruments you need). Need additional extensions of existing number? Put the number needed in the extension block and the telephone number in the lower block. If multiline phone, list all numbers to be installed on the instrument.
5. Remove: Means complete removal of a telephone line/instrument. Care should be taken to let us know if complete telephone number is to be taken out or just extension(s). A 1 by main line will result in removal of number completely, but a 1 by extension means just an extension will be removed. If you want to remove a number from a multiline instrument but leave the number in service elsewhere, indicate appearance after the 1. List telephone number you wish removed in lower block. If removing a multiline instrument, list all numbers on phone.
6. Move: A move can be inside or outside of a building. Tell us if it's a main line or extension(s) you want moved. A move will cover removal and reinstallation of phone in this one column. If multiline phone, list all numbers.
7. Put any additional information or miscellaneous type of work that does not fit anywhere else. Examples: requests for special features, telephone intercoms, loud bells, change ringer, rewiring, etc. Also include in this column justification for new work, class of services (list areas to be accessed), and equipment and systems to be accessed if data request.
8. Put building number, room number or location in building and street name. If new install, leave blank.
9. Put organization, division, branch and section. If new install, leave blank.

10. If new install or move from another building, put building number, location within building and street name. Attach a diagram of location within building.
11. This block must be filled in with complete directory listing (major command, division, section, etc). Indicate whether this number is to be published in telephone directory and telephone information switchboard directory.
12. Fill in at all times. Three classes of service: A1, A2 and C. Within these classes of service are several configuration designed to meet your needs. List areas to be accessed in Block 7 and justification for all Class A service. (Exceptions: work not pertaining to a telephone line, i.e., bells, intercoms, wiring.)
13. Total number of main lines and instruments.
14. Date you submit work request.
15. Name of person requesting service.
16. Signature of Information Management Officer (IMO) or Alternate who has been designated on orders by Commander/Director of organization. Request will be returned if not signed by IMO or alternate.

REMARKS:

Submit one DA Form 3938 for each telephone number to be installed, removed, moved or each miscellaneous job (exception: if moving a multiline instrument within building, one work request will accomplish this if you list all the numbers on the instrument). If you are moving several phones within a building or to another building, attach a diagram of present and proposed locations. (Coordinate large moves with Administrative Telephone Branch. Every effort will be made to simplify paper work.)

Requesting a new A or A2 line or an upgrade? Don't forget to justify and list areas to be accessed (Block 7).

A minimum of 15 days LEAD TIME is required; however, date service required will be subject to slippage depending on equipment availability and contractor workload.

Priorities will be determined on a case-by-case basis. Large moves, renovations, etc., require prior coordination with NEC, Communications Support Branch, and additional lead time.

Help is available for filling out DA Form 3938, using features available on the telephone switch or technical advice.

DEFENSE SWITCHED NETWORK (DSN)

1. GENERAL:

The Defense Switched Network is the principal long haul voice communications command network within the Defense Communications System, providing nonsecure direct-distance dialing service worldwide through a system of Government-owned and leased automatic switching facilities. The purpose of DSN is to handle essential command and control, operations, intelligence, logistical, diplomatic and administrative traffic.

2. PRECEDENCE:

The Joint Uniform Telephone Communications Precedence System is directed for use by all authorized users of voice communications facilities of the Department of Defense. Calls placed over the DSN system are subject to preemption due to the precedence system. Subscribers at Fort Knox are limited to routine calls (Direct Dial) or priority via operator handled.

3. USE OF THE DSN:

- a. Authorized for official communications only.
- b. Restricted to:
 1. Only those official calls which are essential, requiring a timeliness that cannot be obtained by other means (mail, message) and would stand a scrutiny afforded a commercial toll call.
 2. The minimum time required to accomplish the official business and will not normally exceed five minutes.
 3. The use of precedence level in consonance with the subject matter of the call as established in the Joint Communications Precedence System.
 4. Voice, data and graphics service transmitted via DSN will not exceed a continuous transmission time of 18 minutes, nor a total transmission time of 1 hour per day during normal business hours.
- c. DSN is not authorized for:
 1. Unofficial activities except as defined in AR 25-1.
 2. Calls within an area where other government provided service is adequate, i.e., within a PBX area.

3. Unofficial or personal use.

4. Off-net extension of calls into the commercial system at a distant PBX/PAVX, except when such extension has been previously approved by the local authority controlling the distant switchboard.

4. DSN USER CALLING INSTRUCTIONS:

- a. Routine DSN calls:
 1. Verify the DSN number desired.
 2. Listen for dial tone.
 3. Dial the DSN access code 94.
 4. Listen for a second dial tone.
 5. Dial the 7-digit DSN number.
- b. Precedence Calls.
 1. Verify the DSN number desired.
 2. Dial 0 and give the following information to the switchboard attendant:
 - a. Your name, grade, unit and extension number.
 - b. Precedence of call (limited to Priority).
 - c. DSN number desired.
- c. Overseas DSN calls.
 1. Individuals must be on an approved list or have a one-time approval to make such calls. Procedures are outline in AR 25-1.
 2. Persons having the appropriate approval will dial 4-4429 and provide the following information to the Chief Operator:
 - a. Name, grade and telephone number.
 - b. Precedence of Call (limited to Priority).
 - c. City and country to be called, telephone number of unit desired and name or title of person to whom call is directed. Should the city and/or country name be unknown, the information can be obtained by calling the Post Locator, 4-1141, and giving the APO number.

5. DSN ASSISTANCE:

Call assistance, conference and directory assistance for DSN users is available through the local information operator, dial 0 or 13.

6. A LISTING OF DSN NUMBERS:

Locations frequently called by Fort Knox subscribers is immediately following the DSN Information Section.

GENERAL INFORMATION

TELEPHONE USER GUIDE

This listing is for activities and individuals located on the installation who receive their telephone service from the Post Telephone system. Any activity desiring additional information or training on system features should contact the Administrative Telephone Section at 4-2010/7110.

THE SOUNDS YOU HEAR

Here are a few of the sounds you will hear with this system:

SINGLE RING AND PAUSE:

This signals an incoming call from within the post telephone system.

DOUBLE RING AND PAUSE:

This signals an incoming call from outside the post telephone system.

TRIPLE RING AND PAUSE:

This signals a system recall such as a camp-on recall.

FLASH TONE:

This is three short beeps followed by dial tone. You will hear this when you do a hookswitch flash. (Hold down the hook switch for one second and release it.)

CONFIRMATION TONE:

This is two short beeps and signals that a feature has been accessed.

LONG STEADY TONE WHEN DIALING OFF-POST NUMBERS (QUEUE TONE):

This is a signal that all trunks leaving post are busy.

ERROR TONE:

This is a rapid busy tone. If you hear this, hang up and try again.

SYSTEM FEATURES:

CALL HOLD:

- Hookswitch flash

- Listen for flash tone
- Set handset on desk

RETRIEVE CALL HOLD:

Simply hang up. The switch will call you back with your held party-or-hookswitch flash.

CALL TRANSFER:

THREE-WAY CONFERENCE:

CALL FORWARDING:

Call forwarding allows you three options: You can have all your calls forwarded, you can have them forwarded only if your phone is busy or you can have them forwarded only if they are not answered by the fourth ring. You do this by first telling the switch where you want your calls forwarded to using the update access code. Then you turn it on by using the activate access code. This allows you to answer a call that is ringing on another phone from the phone at your desk. (NOTE: For this feature to work, you must be in a pick-up group. This can be accomplished by submitting a DA Form 3938 with the phone numbers you want to be in the pick-up group.)

GROUP PICK-UP:

TRUNK QUEUING:

(This feature is for calls going off post.)

OFF-HOOK QUEUING:
