Soldier/veterans step 1 for self or 2 & 3 for transferability

1. Apply for benefits at www.gibill.va.gov. Select enroll, establish account, then “start VONAPP” use VA 22-1990. (Not required for TEB but recommended).
2. Go to: <https://www.dmdc.osd.mil/TEB> and complete steps listed.
3. Mandated retention requirement. Must have served at least 6 yrs and agree to 4 more. Only your career counselor or branch can confirm retention criteria in your service record. (Enlisted Soldiers= unit Career Counselor - Officers/Warrants contact HRC). If this step is not completed then request will not be approved. Once they finalize your retention then VA is notified overnight of family member information.
4. When Family Member(s), is ready to use the benefit they will need to establish a VA account at the link in step 1 and apply using VA Form 22-1990e then contact the school.
