SUBJECT: USAARMC Policy Memo No. 8-03 - Army Motorcycle Safety Course

1. Reference AR 385-55, Prevention of Motor Vehicle Accidents, Appendix B-3, 12 Mar 87.
2. This memorandum provides guidance and procedures for attendance at the Army Motorcycle Safety Course. To operate on Army installations, military personnel and DOD civilian employees operating a privately or government-owned motorcycle or moped are required to satisfactorily complete an Army-approved motorcycle safety course. The course length is 1 day and consists of classroom instruction, hands-on-training, and successful completion of a hands-on evaluation. Students must bring a valid motorcycle drivers license or learner's permit, registration, and proof of insurance, DOT approved motorcycle helmet, and their own motorcycle to class. The **2004 classes** are scheduled for the following dates: **16 Apr, 21 May, 18 Jun, 16 Jul, 20 Aug, 17 Sep, 15 Oct, and 19 Nov.** Exception to the requirement for completion of this course is granted only if an individual can produce proof of successful completion of an Army-approved motorcycle safety course.
