SUBJECT: Thunderbolt Six Policy Memo No. 40-27 - Withholding Authority to Dispose of
Officer Offenses

1. References.

2. Authority to dispose of UCMJ offenses allegedly committed by commissioned and warrant officers is reserved to the Commanding General, USAARMC.

3. If an officer allegedly violates one or more punitive articles, the brigade/regimental commander or staff director will forward an initial report of the incident as soon as possible, but NLT 24 hours, to the Commanding General and a copy to the Staff Judge Advocate (SJA). This initial report will not be delayed to gather additional facts. Within 72 hours the brigade/regimental commander or director will gather all available facts, evidence, and circumstances and provide a final report, or interim if necessary, to the Commanding General, through the SJA. Final Reports will contain the independent chain of command recommendations for disposition.
