BEFORE YOU MAIL THIS APPLICATION

- 1 - This application is for **non-military** archery hunters only.
- 2 - Is all required information for all hunters **complete, accurate, and legible**? If selected, an information packet will be sent to each individual hunter, so please ensure that each applicant's mailing address is correct.
- 3 - Have you enclosed a cashier's check, certified check, or money order made payable to U.S. Treasury for the proper amount? **NO PERSONAL CHECKS.** Fees for each hunter on the application may be paid on separate money orders **or** combine all hunters' fees on one money order.
- 4 - Applications must be postmarked 1-15 August.
- 5 - Enclose one self-addressed stamped business-size envelope per application.

DATA REQUIRED BY THE PRIVACY ACT OF 1974

- AUTHORITY:** Title 10, US Code, Section 3013, and Army Regulation 190-14, Carrying of Firearms and Use of Force for Law Enforcement Security Duties.
- PURPOSE:** Application for individuals desiring to participate in the Archery Deer Hunt.
- ROUTINE USE:** Information will be used in making selection of individuals who will hunt during the Archery Deer Hunt.
- DISCLOSURE:** Voluntary. Noncompliance will result in individual being ineligible for selection to hunt.

HUNT DATES: 10 September - 13 November

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1 - Incomplete or incorrect applications will result in disqualification.
- 2 - Up to 5 hunters may apply on each application for the Archery Deer Hunt. Submit only one application with appropriate fees per envelope.
- 3 - Hunters will be selected and assigned a weekend for the first phase of the archery season by means of a random drawing. Hunters selected may also hunt weekdays, except Tuesdays, during this phase and all days during the second and third phases of the archery season.
- 4 - Each application should have preferred weekends numbered in order of preference "1-10." Number only the weekends that you are able to hunt. Refunds will not be made to hunters that fail to show on their assigned weekend.
- 5 - All hunters age 12-60 are required to have a state-issued Hunter Education Certificate in their possession at the time of the hunt. The one-time Kentucky hunter education exemption is acceptable, but the hunter must be accompanied by an adult that meets the hunter education requirements above. Hunters 18 years of age and older must have photo ID to enter the installation.
- 6 - The Hunt Control Office will not be responsible for lost or misdirected mail.

APPLICATION DATES

Archery Hunt application period is 1-15 August. Applications must be postmarked no earlier than 1 August and no later than 15 August.

FEES

Permit fees for the 2016 Archery Deer Hunt are **\$30** per adult hunter and **\$15** for youths under the age of 16. Kentucky residents age 65 or older with KY Senior Citizen Hunting and Fishing License and veterans that are 100 percent service-connected disabled with a KY Disabled Hunting and Fishing License are eligible for a free Fort Knox permit. **A copy showing the above status must be attached to the application to receive a free permit.**

REFUNDS

A refund will be made to those individuals not selected to hunt. Refunds **will not** be made to hunters who fail to show.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- 1 – Applicants must use the IMKN-PW Form 1328 for the 2016 Fort Knox Archery Deer Hunt.
- 2 - Up to five names may be included on one application. Applications with more than five names will be disqualified.
- 3 - **Submit only one application for the Archery Deer Hunt; name(s) that appear on more than one Archery Deer Hunt application will result in disqualification of those applications.**
- 4 - **Submit only one application, with the appropriate fees for that application, in an envelope. Envelopes containing more than one application or money orders combining amounts for more than one application will be disqualified.**
- 5 - **Applications must be submitted by mail, postmarked between 1-15 August, with a cashier's check, certified check, or money order made payable to the U.S. Treasury and a self-addressed stamped envelope.**
