

## **CAPTAIN RACHAEL GABBARD**

CPT Rachael Gabbard Commissioned into the United States Army Reserve in May 2006 from ROTC at Xavier University, Cincinnati, Ohio. CPT Gabbard was commissioned as a Medical Service Corps Officer and attended AMEDD Officer Basic Course Fort Sam Houston, Texas.

CPT Gabbard's first assignment, after commissioning, was a Personnel Officer (S1) with the 5010<sup>th</sup> United States Army Hospital located in Louisville, KY. In September 2008 the 5010<sup>th</sup> USAH was relocated to Fort Gordon, GA, upon relocation CPT Gabbard joined the 7218<sup>th</sup> Medical Support Unit, Louisville, KY as S1 Officer. In 2009, CPT Gabbard was selected to deploy in support of Operation Enduring Freedom with the 1207<sup>th</sup> USAH to Kosovo as their Medical Logistics Officer for KFOR12. Upon return in 2010 she joined the Operation Warrior Trainer Program under First Army and was assigned to 4<sup>th</sup> Cavalry Brigade to serve in one of the Battalions in the S3 section and later would join the Headquarters and Headquarters Troop as the Medical Operations Officer.



CPT Gabbard's military education includes the AMEDD Officer Basic Course and Medical Logistics Course. She has a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Criminal Justice from Xavier University.
